NCPTA CALENDAR YEAR 2009 SAFETY AWARD RULES & PROCEDURES

Listed below are the Safety Award Criteria for 2009 and the maximum point's value associated with each category. These categories include traffic accidents, passenger incidents, passenger injuries and safety offenses. **At Fault** (preventable, chargeable) accidents/incidents are defined as any accident, incident, or offense where the driver did not make every reasonable effort to prevent the situation. This determination should be made if any of the following circumstances occur: a police officer issues a ticket/citation, a police report is written, an insurance investigation takes place, passenger injury at time of accident/incident or your agency performs an internal investigation or documents that an accident/incident has occurred. Statistics are based on the calendar year from Jan 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.

- At fault or preventable accidents will be split into three categories.
 - \$500 or more physical and/or property damage.
 - Less than \$500 in physical and/or property damage.
 - Physical and/or property damage includes all vehicles and property involved
 - At fault accidents/incidents involving passenger injury.
- A 25 point deduction will be assessed if your agency has experienced an at fault accident, incident, safety offense with damage greater than \$25,000 (physical and/or property damage) and/or a fatality occurred.
- Total points will be totaled and the agency with the highest score in their category will win.

At fault accident(s), incident(s), or safety offense(s) with \$500 or more
(physical and or property damage) divided by total miles. 40 max points

At fault accident(s), incident(s), or safety offense(s) with less than \$500
(physical and or property damage) divided by total miles. 30 max points

At fault accident(s), incident(s), or safety offense(s) involving passenger injury
divided by passenger trips/boarding's. 30 max points

Total 100 max points

At fault accident(s), incident(s), or safety offense(s) with damage greater than \$25,000 (physical and or property damage) and or a fatality occurred. 25-point deduction

TieBreaker: The tiebreaker will be the least amount of total accidents, incidents, and safety offenses per 100,000 miles.
