Study Conclusions

- ❖ **TLDP has value to the participants being trained to be future leaders related to developing and applying enhanced communication and leadership skills**
- ❖ **This type of learning excited the participants and energized them to return to their work environments ready to address existing challenges and be able to identify new challenges**
- ❖ **The students of TLDP share experiences and learning trajectories during the first seminar, with participants experiencing a transformative moment**
- ❖ **Knowledge gained at TLDP is viewed as being helpful not only in a participant's professional life, but in the personal life as well**
- ❖ **The benefits of leadership training are not only of high value to the participants, but also to their transportation agencies**
